Newcastle Light Rail

Installation of Civic light rail stop - Tuesday 12 June

The NSW Government is investing more than \$650 million through the Revitalising Newcastle program to transform Newcastle's city centre.

Light rail is an important part of the Revitalising Newcastle program and will deliver frequent and reliable connections to key activity precincts in the city centre. Downer is building light rail on behalf of Transport for NSW.

Installation of the steel frame and canopy for Civic light rail stop will be carried out on Hunter Street, between Auckland and Merewether streets, between **8pm Tuesday 12 June** and **4.30am Wednesday 13 June 2018**, weather permitting.

The frame will be preassembled off-site before being transported to Civic for installation.

Pedestrian and traffic changes

Hunter Street between Auckland and Merewether streets will be temporarily closed to all traffic during this work.

The frame and canopy will be transported on a semi-trailer to Hunter Street via Stewart Avenue, King Street and Auckland Street.

The pedestrian crossing at Civic will be temporarily removed during this work. Pedestrian access on the northern and southern footpaths on Hunter Street will be maintained.

What equipment will be used?

Equipment will include, but is not limited to, a crane, grinders, welding equipment, generators, temporary lighting, trucks, light vehicles, power tools and hand tools.

How will the work affect you?

There may be some noise associated with this work. We will aim to minimise the impact of our work by:

- › turning machinery off when not in use
- › positioning noisy equipment as far away as possible from residents and businesses
- › using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- › minimising the number of machines and equipment operating at any one time.
