## Newcastle Light Rail

# Construction update for Beresford Street from Thursday 6 September

**The NSW Government has invested more than \$650 million through the Revitalising Newcastle program to transform Newcastle's city centre.**

Thank you for your patience during recent work at the new light rail depot and on surrounding streets. Major light rail construction in the area is nearing completion, in readiness for arrival of the first light rail vehicle.

To ensure work is completed as quickly as possible, work will continue at night and on Sundays in and near the new depot and stabling facility. Work will involve concreting, steel fixing, laying light rail track, and installation of lighting and overhead wiring. Road work will also continue on Beresford Street.

### When will work take place?

Work will be carried out between **6pm and 7am** from **Monday 10 to Friday 14 September**, and on Sundays between **8am and 6pm** until **Sunday 16 September 2018**, weather permitting.

**Intermittent traffic changes will be in place on Beresford Street between 7am and 6pm until Friday 21 September, to allow final deliveries of rail and concrete pours for the light rail track.**

### Traffic changes

To ensure work can be carried out safely, **traffic control and temporary traffic diversions will be in place as required on Beresford Street. Please see the table overleaf for more details.** Please follow the direction of signs and traffic controllers.

### Pedestrian changes

Temporary pedestrian diversion will be in place as required. Pedestrian access to businesses and residents will be maintained at all times.

### What equipment will be used?

Equipment will include, but is not limited to, excavators, road profilers, road and concrete saws, asphalt pavers, rollers, concrete pumps and trucks, rock and concrete hammers, road sweepers, line marking equipment, water carts, compactors, fork lifts, cranes, trucks, light vehicles, lighting towers, generators and hand tools.

<b>Thursday 6 September</b>	Removal of existing road surface on Beresford Street	Local traffic access only on Beresford Street and the northern end of Bellevue Street. Entry and exit to Beresford Street via Bellevue Street.
<b>Friday 7 September</b>	Laying new road surface on Beresford Street	<b>Beresford Street and the northern end of Bellevue Street temporarily closed.</b> Access to private driveways on Beresford Street and 25 Bellevue Street will be temporarily unavailable between 8am and 3pm.
<b>Tuesday 11 September and Wednesday 12 September</b>	Concrete pour (concrete truck will be parked on Beresford Street)	Local traffic access only on Beresford Street. Temporary traffic diversions will be in place as required. Access to driveways will be maintained.
<b>Thursday 13 September</b>	Rail delivery (truck and crane will be parked on Beresford Street)	Local traffic access only on Beresford Street. Temporary traffic diversions will be in place as required. Access to the eastern driveway at 25 Beresford Street will be temporarily unavailable between 8.30am and 4pm.
<b>Friday 14 September and Monday 17 September to Friday 21 September</b>	Concrete pours and track work (concrete truck will be parked on Beresford Street)	Local traffic access only on Beresford Street. Temporary traffic diversions will be in place as required. Access to driveways will be maintained.

*\*The above times are subject to change due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances*

### How will the work affect you?

There may be some noise associated with this work. We understand our work may be disruptive and we apologise for the inconvenience. We aim to minimise the impact of our work by:

- › turning machinery off when not in use
- › using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery (excluding delivery vehicles)
- › minimising the number of machines and equipment operating at any one time.
