## Intersection upgrade update

**The NSW Government making it easier to get around the city centre by delivering important road upgrades, new connections and better intersections.**

Transport for NSW has engaged Downer to carry out the work.

**The intersection upgrade at Hannell Street and Honeysuckle Drive is expected to be completed by the end of this month.**

Remaining work includes adjustments to traffic lights, line marking, the installation of smart poles, landscaping and other finishing work.

### **What work has been completed so far?**

Work started in March 2018 and work completed to date includes:

- › relocation of underground services
- › installation of pedestrian islands and a new pedestrian crossing across Hannell Street
- › footpath upgrades on the eastern side of Hannell Street
- › a dedicated left-turn slip lane (southbound) from Hannell Street onto Honeysuckle Drive
- › an additional right-hand turn lane (northbound) from Hannell Street onto Honeysuckle Drive.

### **When will the remaining work take place?**

Work will be carried out between **7am** and **6pm Monday to Friday** and between **8am** and **6pm** on **Saturdays**, weather permitting.

To minimise traffic disruptions, some work will take place at night between 6pm and 7am Monday to Friday. We will notify nearby residents and businesses before any night work takes place.

### **Traffic and pedestrian changes**

Temporary traffic and pedestrian controls will be in place as required. Access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times.

### **What equipment will be used?**

Equipment will include, but is not limited to, cranes, line marking equipment, elevated work platforms, trucks, light vehicles, and power and hand tools.

### **How will the work affect you?**

There may be some noise associated with this work. We understand our work may be disruptive and we apologise for the inconvenience. We aim to minimise the impact of our work by:

- › turning machinery off when not in use
- › using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- › minimising the number of machines and equipment operating at any one time
- › monitoring noise during construction.
