Newcastle Light Rail

Night work from Tuesday 20 November

The NSW Government has invested more than \$650 million through the Revitalising Newcastle program to transform Newcastle's city centre.

Light rail is an important part of the Revitalising Newcastle program and will deliver frequent and reliable connections to key activity precincts in the city centre. Downer is building light rail on behalf of Transport for NSW.

Due to a late shipment of pavers, **paving work at Market Street light rail stop has been rescheduled from Sunday 18 November to the following nights:**

- › **6pm Tuesday 20 to 7am Wednesday 21 November**
- › **6pm Wednesday 21 to 7am Thursday 22 November**
- › **6pm Thursday 22 to 7am Friday 23 November**
- › **6pm Monday 26 to 7am Tuesday 27 November**

The above times are subject to approval and weather permitting.
Work will include paving, sealing and other finishing work.

Traffic and pedestrian changes

Traffic changes are not required for this work.
Pedestrian access will be maintained.

What equipment will be used?

Equipment will include, but is not limited to, grinders, saw cutters, forklifts, high-pressure washers, trucks, light vehicles, generators, and power and hand tools.

How will the work affect you?

There will be noise associated with this work. We understand our work may be disruptive and we apologise for the inconvenience. We aim to minimise the impact of our work by:

- › turning machinery off when not in use
- › using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- › completing noisiest activities before 10pm wherever possible
- › minimising the number of machines and equipment operating at any one time.
