October 2018 NIGHT WORK

Project overview

Newcastle Interchange is the new major transport hub for the city and the Hunter, linking trains, buses, taxis, a kiss and ride bay, and from early 2019, Newcastle Light Rail. It is a key part of the NSW Government's plan to revitalise Newcastle.

Upcoming work

Subject to approval, maintenance work on the station platforms will be carried out at night between **8pm and 4am** from **Tuesday 16 to Thursday 18 October 2018** and **Tuesday 23 to Thursday 25 October 2018** when there are fewer commuters in the area.

Work will include electrical work, drainage work and maintenance to the station roof and air conditioning system.

A range of equipment will be used to complete the work including elevated work platforms, crane, hand tools, lighting towers, jackhammers, scaffolding, concrete saw, and light vehicles.

While all efforts to reduce potential impacts to businesses and residents have been made, there may be some noise and vibration associated with this work.
