Newcastle Light Rail

Zone 6 power outage

The NSW Government is investing more than \$650 million through the Revitalising Newcastle program to transform Newcastle's city centre.

Light rail is an important part of the Revitalising Newcastle program and will deliver frequent and reliable connections to key activity precincts in the city centre. Downer is building light rail on behalf of Transport for NSW.

Installation of electrical infrastructure and cabling will be carried out on Scott Street between Brown and Wolfe streets (zone 6) this **Sunday, 20 May**. This work will involve a temporary electrical outage.

When will the outage take place?

Electricity is expected to be out for about twelve hours from **5am to 5pm on Sunday 20 May**, subject to weather and other unforeseen circumstances.

We have contacted affected businesses and will be providing generators to provide an alternative power supply during the outage. Residents are not expected to be impacted by the outage

More information will be provided to affected businesses from their service provider before the outage takes place.

What equipment will be used?

Equipment will include, but is not limited to, excavators, utility vehicles, trucks, generators, power tools and hand tools.

Pedestrian and traffic changes

Work will be carried out within the existing construction zone. No additional pedestrian or traffic controls are required.
