

# Newcastle Light Rail

## Know the rules

New road signs are being introduced throughout the city centre, which show how motorists, cyclists and pedestrians behave around light rail vehicles and tracks.



The speed limit for all vehicles, including light rail vehicles, on Hunter and Scott streets is **40km/h**.



**Do not enter areas marked 'Tram Only'** and keep to your lane where you see this sign.



**Road users will share a lane with trams** on Scott Street between Newcomen and Pacific streets.



These warning signs alert road users that light rail is running in the area.



These warning signs will be placed near intersections to alert pedestrians that light rail is running in the area.

By the end of the year, light rail will be a regular sight throughout the Newcastle city centre as we prepare for services to start running in early 2019. This means now is the time to get up to speed with what light rail's arrival will mean for getting around the city centre.
