

Bus changes

From Sunday 10 September 2017

The way we use our city is changing

As we prepare for the start of light rail construction, there will be changes to bus stops on Hunter and Scott streets.

From **Sunday 10 September 2017** Hunter Street buses will be diverted at Union Street. Customers travelling east of Union Street will travel on King and Watt streets, with the exception of routes 106 and 107, which will use Honeysuckle Drive and Wharf Road.

The routes affected by this change are listed on the centerfold map.

These bus stops will be closed:

Inbound:

- › Hunter St opp Wheeler Plaza
- › Hunter St opp Darby St
- › Scott St opp Perkins St
- › Scott St opp Wolfe St
- › Scott St near Newcastle Station

Outbound:

- › Watt St near King St
- › Scott St before Bolton St
- › Scott St before Wolfe St
- › Scott St before Hunter St
- › Hunter St before Darby St
- › Hunter St near Auckland St
- › Hunter St before Union St

New bus stops will be located:

Inbound:

- › King St after Union St
- › University House, King St
- › King St after Darby St
- › King St at Perkins St
- › Customs House, Watt St
- › Wharf Rd opp Argyle St
- › Queens Wharf, Wharf Rd

Outbound:

- › Customs House, Watt St
- › King St at Bolton St
- › King St at Perkins St
- › King St before Darby St
- › King St after Auckland St
- › Union St at King St
- › Queens Wharf, Wharf Rd
- › Wharf Rd before Argyle St

These routes will divert onto King Street, via Union Street

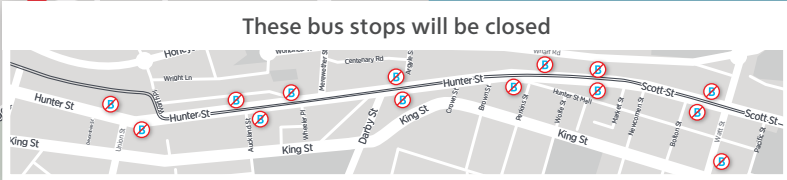
These routes will continue onto Wharf Road
