Construction update

18–19 AUGUST 2018 WEEKEND WORK

Project overview

Newcastle Interchange is the new major transport hub for the city and the Hunter, linking trains, buses, taxis, a kiss and ride bay, and from early 2019, Newcastle Light Rail. It is a key part of the NSW Government's plan to revitalise Newcastle.

Upcoming work

Subject to approval, maintenance work will be carried out continuously (24hrs) during a scheduled rail shutdown from 7am Saturday 18 August to 6pm Sunday 19 August 2018. This is to ensure work can be completed safely when no trains are running and there are fewer pedestrians, motorists and commuters in the area.

Work will include rectification and maintenance activities at Railway Street pedestrian footbridge and Newcastle Interchange, and the replacement of some pavers.

The Railway Street pedestrian footbridge will be closed during this time. Pedestrian access between Station Street and Hunter Street will be via Stewart Avenue.

A range of equipment will be used to complete the work including elevated work platforms, hand held tools, lighting towers, jackhammers, concrete cutting saw and light vehicles.

While all efforts to reduce potential impacts to businesses and residents have been made, there may be some noise and vibration associated with this work.
