Night work from Thursday 29 November

The NSW Government is funding important road upgrades across the city centre to improve traffic flow and safety for road users.

Transport for NSW has engaged Downer to carry out the work.

Night work will be completed at the Hunter Street and Stewart Avenue intersection from **Thursday 29 November 2018** for about three weeks.

Work will include excavation, installation of new kerbs, footpath upgrades, laying new road surface, line marking and other finishing work.

When will work take place?

Night work will be carried out between **6pm** and **7am Mondays to Fridays** from **Thursday 29 November**, subject to approval and weather permitting.

Pedestrian and traffic changes

Temporary traffic and pedestrian controls will be in place as required.

During road re-surfacing work, temporary lane closures will be in place. At least one lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction at all times, with intermittent stops in place.

Please follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

Access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times.

What equipment will be used?

Equipment will include, but is not limited to, excavators, asphalt pavers, rollers, milling equipment, rock and concrete hammers, road saws, trucks, utility vehicles, trucks, lighting towers, generators, power tools and hand tools.

How will the work affect you?

There may be some noise and vibration associated with this work. We will aim to minimise the impact of our work by:

- › turning machinery off when not in use
- › positioning noisy equipment as far away as possible from residents and businesses wherever possible
- › scheduling noisiest activities before 10pm wherever possible
- › using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- › minimising the number of machines and equipment operating at any one time.
